- Full PPE shall be worn at all times; traffic vests with bunker bottoms and helmets are acceptable at MVA's if you are not involved with extrication or treating trapped patients.
- SCBA shall be worn on all jobs except MVA's.
- Paramedic personnel may be assigned to care for the sick and/or injured. Should this occur, the company officer will delegate the paramedic's job task assignments to another member of the company.
- Should there be an extra firefighter (FF3) assigned to the company, they shall be assigned to the outside team and/or will assist the D/O with their job task assignments
- Radio call names are as follows:
  - Lt. – L72
  - D/O – L72 driver
  - FF1 – L72 Mic 1
  - FF2 – L72 Mic 2
  - FF3 – L72 Mic 3
